All entries must be submitted in HY-TEK file to Eva Gronke at eva@fastswimresults.com and a pdf file to justswim5006@aol.com by Monday, October 16, 2017 by 5:00 PM. Entries failing to make the deadline may result in not being entered in the meet. Follow all FHSAA protocols for official entries. Relay cards will be provided at the meet. A student athlete whose name was not originally submitted on the Official Entry List is not eligible to participate in the district meet until the additional of his or her name is approved by the FHSAA office.

Each team is allowed a maximum of 4 swimmers per event; each swimmer shall be limited to a maximum of 4 events, no more than 2 of which may be individual events. Follow all rules of the 2017-2018 NFHS rules book and the FHSAA Swimming & Diving Manual.

Relays: Any swimmer on your Master Entry Form may be eligible for a relay. Include all Relay Only swimmers in the HY-TEK Entry File. Prior to the start of the relay events, you must turn in your relay card listing your relay swimmers. Relay cards must also designate the name of the lead-off swimmers who actually swims in the lead-off position. You may list up to 8 swimmers per relay.
Reminder: You MAY NOT scratch a swimmer from an individual event in order to swim and additional relay.

Scratches: A swimmer who is entered into an individual event in the FHSAA State Swimming & Diving Series on any level and is later scratched from that event will be disqualified from participating in all remaining events in that meet and all succeeding levels.

A coach or HS representative should be present at the competition to sign dive sheets.

The following must be included on each sheet:

1. Dive Number
2. Written Description
3. Position
4. Degree of Difficulty
5. Order in which dives will be attempted.

Order of Competition:

Preliminary Round: 2 voluntary dives and 3 optional dives
Semi-Final Round: 2 voluntary dives and 1 optional dive
Final Round: 1 voluntary dive and 2 optional dives

Note: Each listed optional dive must represent all five diving categories; All divers must meet NFHS standards and regulations in addition to the FHSAA Swimming & Diving Manual.
