- Scoring:** Individual: 20, 17,16,15,14,13,12,11,9,7,6,5,4,3,2,1
Relay: 40, 34,32,30,28,26,24,22,18,14,12,10,8,6,4,2
- Awards:** Girls Team Champion and Runner-up, Boys Team Champion and Runner-up
- Entries:** Official Entry List must be submitted by Monday, October 9, 2017, 5:00 PM to FHSAA Team Manager site.
- All entries with times (SW3 forms or Hy-tek file) must be submitted via email by Thursday, October 20, 2017, 5:00 PM to: Eva Gronke eva@fastswimresults.com
- Entries failing to make the deadline may result in not being entered in the meet. Follow all FHSAA protocols for official entries. Relay cards will be provided the morning of meet.
- A student athlete whose name was not originally submitted on the official entry list is not eligible to participate in the district meet until the addition of his or her name is approved by the FHSAA office.
- Each team is allowed a maximum of 4 swimmers per event; each contestant shall be limited to a maximum of 4 events, no more than two of which may be individual events. Follow all rules of the 2017-2018 NFHS rules book and the FHSAA Swimming & Diving Manual.
- Relays:** Any swimmer on your Master Entry form (SW3 or HyTek file) may be eligible for a relay. Prior to the start of the relay events, you must turn in your relay card listing your relay swimmers. Relay card must also designate the name of the lead-off swimmer who actually swims in the lead-off position. You may list up to 8 swimmers. Reminder: You MAY NOT scratch a swimmer from an individual event in order to swim an additional relay.
- Scratches:** Scratches: A contestant who is entered and does not show up/scratches at the time of the preliminary event or does not show up/scratches for a final event shall be disqualified for the remainder of the meet. Once the competitor's name has been entered for the event, he/she is charged with that event. 207.02 Failure to Appear and Compete.
Meet Regulations, 207.01 (3) (a) Scratched Contestant. A contestant who is entered into an individual event in the FHSAA State Swimming & Diving Series on any level and is later scratched from that event will be disqualified from participating in all remaining events in that meet as an individual on succeeding levels in that event.

Diving Sheets: Divers must be listed on the school's Master Entry Form. **FINAL** dive sheets must be submitted no later than 11am on Tues. Oct 24th to spurgeon@pcsb.org. Each contestant must submit a signed diving score sheet at 10:30am on October 26th, which include the following:

1. Dive number
2. Written description
3. Position
4. Degree of difficulty
5. Order in which dives will be attempted
6. Voluntary dives must be marked on the dive sheet

Order of Completion: Preliminary Round: 2 voluntary dives and 3 optional dives
Semi-final Round: 2 voluntary dives and 1 optional dive
Final Round: 1 voluntary dive and 2 optional dives

NOTE: Each optional dive MUST represent ALL 5 diving categories; no minimum total degree of difficulty for optional dives for entry into the meet; degree of difficulty for all dives listed in the NF Rules book. Changes to dive sheets will be permitted until 60 minutes prior to the start of the dive competition (FHSA rules book)

Diving Judges: All high school diving coaches

Announcer: Seminole High School

Spectator Fee: \$6.00 entry fee for diving spectators, no parents or spectators are to be on the deck during the competition.
