Pool Specs: Certified 25 yard outdoor pool with a maximum of two eleven lane racing courses, having a minimum depth of 5 feet and non-turbulent lane lines.

Timing System: Electronic timing system w/ LED scoreboard, manual back-up watches, Computer Scoring

Entry Fee: None. We will prorate any financial loss among all Region 4A-2 participating schools.

Spectator Fee: \$7.00 per person, per session

Scoring: Individual: 20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
Relay: 40, 34, 32, 30, 28, 26, 24, 22, 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2

Entries: All entries will be determined by the FHSAA after the completion of the 4A District 4, 5, & 6 Swimming & Diving Championships and forwarded to Eva Gronke our Meet Hy-Tek Operator for meet entry.
Each team is allowed 4 athletes per event; each athlete shall be limited to 4 events, no more than 2 of which may be individual events. Follow all rules of the 2017-2018 NFHS rule book and the FHSAA Swimming & Diving manual.

Relays: Any swimmer on your Master Entry Form (SW3 or Hy-Tek file) may be eligible for a relay prior to the start of the relay events; each relay team must turn in a relay card to the timer when you check in with the names of each swimmer on your relay. You must list your swimmers in the order that they will swim. Reminder: You MAY NOT scratch a swimmer from an individual event in order to swim an additional relay.

Scratches: A contestant who is entered and does not show up/scratches at the time of the Timed Final event shall be disqualified for the remainder of the meet. (Once the competitor's name has been entered for the event, he/she is charged with that event) 207.02.
Failure to Appear and Compete, Meet Regulations, 207.01 (3) (a) Scratched Contestant.
A contestant who is entered into an individual event in the FHSAA State Swimming & Diving Series on any level and is later scratched from that event will be disqualified from participating in all remaining events in that meet as an individual on succeeding levels of the State Series.

We may dive boys and girls together, it will depend on how many entries.

Diving Sheets: Divers must be listed on the school's Master Entry Form; a rough draft dive sheet should be submitted to Katie Linton (katielinton85@gmail.com). Dive sheets must be submitted **no later than noon on Tuesday, November 3rd**. Questions can be directed to Katie Linton. Each contestant should submit two signed diving score sheets which include the following:

1. Dive number
2. Written description
3. Position
4. Degree of difficulty
5. Order in which dives will be attempted

Order of Completion: Preliminary Round: 2 voluntary dives and 3 optional dives
Semi-final Round: 2 voluntary dives and 1 optional dive
Final Round: 1 voluntary dive and 2 optional dives

NOTE: Each optional dive MUST represent ALL 5 diving categories; no minimum total degree of difficulty for optional dives for entry into the meet; degree of difficulty for all dives listed in the NFHS Rules book.

Diving Referees: TBA

Diving Judges: All high school diving coaches; each school should provide one team representative for the divers

Announcer: Countryside High School

Spectator Fee: \$7.00 entry fee for diving spectators, no parents or spectators are to be in the diving area during the competition.
