**Directions:** From I-95, exit East on Glades Road. Turn right (South) at first stop light. Turn right (West) into school parking lot.

From Florida Turnpike, exit East on Glades Road. Turn right (South) at first stop light after crossing I-95. Turn right (West) into school parking lot.

**Pool:** On Campus. Next to the Stadium.

**Diving**

Two one meter diving boards separated by a three meter board.

**Swimming**

20 x 25 yard lanes, 8 lanes will be used for the competition course with 2 buffer lanes on each side, 8 lanes available for warm up/warm down before, during and after competition.

**Rules:** 2016-17 National Federation of Swimming and Diving Rules and Records for Championship meets as amended by the FHSAA.

- Girls Only Warm-up – 10:00-10:30am
- Girls Event Start – 10:35am
- Boys Warm-up – 40 minutes long – Immediately following the girls event
- Boys Event Start – Following Warm-up

- You do not have to bring a dive sheet with you to the pool, we will print out a dive sheet to be signed by the diver and the attending coach. This process will allow you to double check the dive order that has been entered into the computer.

Each diver must have his or her school coach, assistant coach, or official school representative from their school he or she is representing at this event in order to compete. Private diving coaches, or USA diving coaches cannot act as a representative yet may act in a coaching role. **Divers not having a coach, assistant coach, or official school representative of the school that diver is representing will not be allowed to compete.**

FHSAA and NFHS rules apply for the diving list format:

- Prelims: 24 boys and 24 girls allowed for prelims
  - o 2 required dives & 3 optional dives in any order
- Semi-Finals: cut to top 20 boys and top 20 girls before semi-finals
  - o 2 required dives & 1 optional dive in any order
- Finals: cut to top 16 boys and top 16 girls before finals
  - o 1 required dive & 2 optional dives in any order

## **Swimming – Thursday, October 27<sup>th</sup>**

Timed Finals: Warm-up: 3:00pm - Meet Start: 5:00pm
